

## **European Biodiversity Strategy 2030**



Legally protect at least 30% of the land (incl. freshwater), and 30% of the sea in the EU.


At least 1/3 of this should be strictly protected



Include **restoration on 20%** of lands by actively or passively assisting towards **good condition** 




Facilitate ecological corridors and support sustainable land management, while increasing resilience through climate mitigation and adaptation

EU Member states commitments towards increased protection




Only **7** Member States out of 27 have notified the European Commission of their commitments.


## 10% "Strict" protection

### Challenge of finding EU applicable definition

Most strictly protected area should be non-intervention areas, and active management within strictly protected area, should be the exception to the rule (EC Guidance on Protected Area Designations, 2022).


### A reminder







## International collaboration across scales is key




